CASE STUDY: Tornado Recovery

Disasters come in all shapes and sizes. On July 14, 2004, an F3 tornado hit South Londonderry Township near Campbelltown. With internal winds up to 200 mph, the twister demolished 37 homes and ravaged dozens of others. Miraculously, no lives were lost.



Compleat Restorations responded by rushing supplies to the Red Cross and dispatching our Mobile Command Unit to the scene.

Used for large-scale disasters, our Mobile Command Unit is an office on wheels, equipped with computers, phones, printers, meeting space, food & water. During the first critical days of the Campbelltown disaster, it meant we could work more effectively assessing damages and coordinating emergency services. The on-site headquarters greatly enhanced communications among our customers, their insurance carriers, our emergency response crews and restoration teams.



Our employees worked tirelessly helping stunned victims sift through debris, clean up the damage, pack their belongings and begin repairs. Repairs and restorations were made to some homes, but others had to be totally demolished, then rebuilt.

We are happy to report that with the professional assistance of Compleat Restorations, many families have returned to their homes, or will return by Christmas.
